D&RGW K-28 is a product of the American Locomotive Works (ALCO). It was delivered to the Denver & Rio Grande Western in 1923. A total of ten K-28's (470-479) were purchased to assist the very successful by now severely over-worked K-27's. Since the delivery of the K-27's in 1903 the technology and complexity of steam locomotive had advanced considerably. Therefore the K-28 although similar in size to the K-27 is a much more advanced piece of equipment. A long "leisurely visual tour" of your new Accucraft K-28 will allow you to spot many of these advanced features all faithfully modelled on your new locomotive.
