NSW Govt. Railways 'BCH' Bogie Coal Hopper

After WWII the NSW Govt. Railways introduced the 'BCH' Bogie Coal Hopper to replace the four-wheelers it had made do with since the 1860s. Weighing 19 tons when empty and 60 when full. 2,750 were built with many being converted to BWH grain wagons. Long trains of these could be seen behind a range of NSW steam locomotives including AD60s and C38s.

Given the challenge of providing affordable quality models for the Australian market, Argyle has chosen the 1:32 scale American 3 bay hopper as a basis for this model and applied the livery and lettering of the NSWGR 'BCH'. This model will appeal to those modelers seeking an inexpensive, ready to run 1:32 scale NSWGR goods train and who can accommodate the package of affordability, availability, appearance and correct scale. Available individually or as a set of 4 with different road numbers. Also available without a road number in the side decal so customers can install their own alternate numbers.
