## 'TORNADO' LNER Live Steam 4-6-2



The A1 Steam Locomotive Trust, a registered charity, built Peppercorn class A1 Pacific 60163 Tornado. The class A1s were designed by Arthur H Peppercorn for the London & North Eastern Railway and 49 were built in 1948/49 by British Railways. However, all were scrapped following the

dieselisation of the railways. After 18 years of planning, construction and fundraising the £3 million locomotive was completed in 2008 becoming the first main line steam locomotive to be built since 1960.
