1:32 Scale RCH 7 Plank Wagon



These seven plank 'Railway Clearing House' wagons are based on the 1923 RCH design and represents a type that was built by the tens of thousands, many for private owners. A rugged and simple design employing standard RCH fittings throughout and originally they had to be built with seven side planks. Various configurations of side doors, end door and bottom doors were permitted, but the weight of the unladen wagon was not to be above 7 tons 5 cwt. Oil lubrication and brakes on both sides were mandatory. The main line railway companies adopted RCH fittings for many of their own designs, and the LMS and LNER adopted the RCH 1923 mineral wagon as their standard
