ACCUCRAFT TRAINS (USA)
C-25 D&RGW 2-8-0, LIVE STEAM



This locomotive, a 2-8-0 or Consolidation type was a standard Baldwin design and was built in 1903 as C/N 21757. It had 33" drivers, 18x20" cylinders, and a tractive effort just short of 25,000 pounds. The D&RG purchased this locomotive from the Crystal River Railroad in 1916 and was the best steamer on the railroad at that time. Sadly, on June 21, 1949 the one and only C-25 on the D&RGW was scrapped at Alamosa, Colorado.
