British Railways Mk1 RMB (Restaurant Miniature Buffet)



The Restaurant Miniature Buffet (or RMB) was a Tourist Standard Open (TSO) coach with two full seating bays next to the centre transverse vestibule removed and replaced with a buffet counter and customers' standing space, and one bay on one side (same side as the buffet counter) removed and replaced with a store cupboard on the other side of the centre vestibule. They were built in five lots from 1957 to 1962. Designed to provide catering facilities where a full dining service was not required, they served on all four regions, and many have found further use in mainline rail tour trains or on preserved lines.

The models feature flush glaze windows, sprung brass buffers, Kadee knuckle couplings throughout, flexible rubber corridor connectors and metal bogies with insulated steel wheels & axles running in roller bearings. Full interior compartment detailing.
