



South Australian Steam Up

"Steam in September" Sponsored by Argyle Locomotive Works

Argyle in conjunction with Penfield Model Engineers are pleased to announce the inaugural South Australian Steam Up for 45mm gauge enthusiasts.

Hosted at Penfield Miniature Railway – the weekend will be held over 19th and 20th September from 8:30am – 4:30pm. All locomotives in 45mm gauge are allowed – Electric, Steam, Internal Combustion – No Track power.

A Sausage Sizzle will be provided for Lunch on the Saturday and Sunday lunch is TBC. Limited soft drinks and ice-creams are available for purchase, tea and coffee will be available over the weekend.

Track:

Penfield has 3 large circuits of 45mm track outdoor in a raised garden bed/track bed, 9m x 25m.

There is a small industrial area, a number of steaming bay locations along with yard space suitable for multiple trains.

Common Radii of track is 3.5m- large enough for almost all visiting locos.

Facilities:

Preparation tables are provided in the middle of the track, One duck under/removable bridge and one set of stairs with handrail are provided for entry to the middle of the layout if required.

Limited seating is available out in the park so we recommend attendees bring their own folding chairs.

Toilets are located on-site but we advise bore water is utilised for watering grounds – tap water from outside taps is not suitable for drinking or locomotives.

Fuel and Water:

Limited fuel and water will be available for attendees – emergency butane and distilled water will be available. Steam Oil is available and will be Mobil Super Cylinder Oil – ISO460 & suitable for most live steam locomotives.

Social Event:

On Saturday 19th a social event will be held at the St Kilda Tramway Museum, Argyle has organised a private event from 5-7pm at a cost of \$10 per head. This includes entry to the museum and tram rides on a selection of operational trams. Dinner will be at the St Kilda Hotel at 7:15pm (At own Cost). Tramway museum event is subject to minimum numbers.

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Boiler Requirements:

The steam-up is open to all locomotives, a requirement is to demonstrate a working safety valve for steam locomotives.

All boilers should be in good condition with no major steam leaks, operators are responsible for ensuring the locomotives are “safe to operate” should there be any questions or concerns please contact Brenton or Pete.

Housekeeping and General:

As we are utilising a club environment we ask that all rubbish is placed in the bins provided, Attendees are requested to be respectful of the club environment and treat the grounds and equipment with respect and care.

Entry will be at 8:15am and gates will close at 4:45pm sharp
Engineman will be required to book a 30 minute timeslot and specify Outer, Middle or Inner Tracks, the industrial area can be operated by the outer track or alternatively by an additional operator with permission from the Outer track timeslot holder. Please be respectful of other attendees and stay within your allotted timeslot – if there is a space either side of the time you have booked please confer with any other attendees booked in prior to extending your timeslot.

Timeslots may only be taken on the running list once per operator prior to 9:45am, after this you may nominate additional timeslots – please be mindful that everyone should get a chance to run their locomotives.
